Introduction (15 pts.)	Introduction must be 5 sentences and include the following: Attention grabber Background info introduces author & book, provides a bridge to thesis Quality thesis statement (final sentence)
Conclusion (15 pts.)	Conclusion must be 4-5 sentences and include the following: Restated, but not directly repeated thesis (first 1-2 sentences) Extend the essay's ideas without repeating previous points Makes a broader application Reflect the attention grabber
Body Paragraphs (20 pts.)	Each body paragraph must contain: Clear topic sentence Two quotes (proofs) per paragraph Transition wording between proofs Clincher sentence (reflects topic sentence) All information within each paragraph directly relates to the paragraph topic
Quotes/evidence (20 pts.)	Variety of quotes (spread throughout the book) Quotes within each body paragraph follow chronological order Quotes are well blended (no stand alone quotes, no block quotes) Plenty of contextual info (assertion) is provided for each quote Clear commentary provided which ties each quote to what you are proving "Quotes are cited correctly" (Lastname #).

Content (10 pts.)	Essay proves thesis statement Essay clearly portrays author's view, does not read like a book report
