Pilgrim's Progress Annotation Guide

BE SURE TO APPLY THESE REQUIREMENTS TO EACH SECTION OF THE PILGRIM'S PROGRESS:

- 1. One <u>quality</u> annotation per spread. (Spread = left & right side of an open book)
- 2. Quality annotations must show variety and fall under one of the following categories:
 - Literary device (e.g., plot structure, plot device, figures of speech, etc.)
 - Defined vocabulary word
 - Character description (Quality adjectives!)
 - Themes
 - Questions and answers (questions must be answered for credit)
 - Setting
 - Useful reactions to characters & events (avoid slang/idioms!!)
- 3. Every spread that lacks a quality annotation will lose 1 point.
- 4. If your annotations fail to show variety, you will lose points.
- 5. You may not use the existing annotations in the margins in any way as part of your own note-taking.
