

## Pilgrim's Progress Annotation Guide

**BE SURE TO APPLY THESE REQUIREMENTS TO EACH SECTION OF *THE PILGRIM'S PROGRESS*:**

1. One quality annotation per spread. (Spread = left & right side of an open book)
2. Quality annotations must show variety and fall under one of the following categories:
  - Literary device (e.g., plot structure, plot device, figures of speech, etc.)
  - Defined vocabulary word
  - Character description (Quality adjectives!)
  - Themes
  - Questions and answers (questions must be answered for credit)
  - Setting
  - Useful reactions to characters & events (avoid slang/idioms!!)
3. Every spread that lacks a quality annotation will lose 1 point.
4. If your annotations fail to show variety, you will lose points.
5. You may not use the existing annotations in the margins in any way as part of your own note-taking.
