Student's refutation section should include:

- A well-written topic sentence that:
  - Addresses both the opposition's argument and the "turn back"
  - Ties back to overall argument in thesis
  - Free from "be" verbs
- Subject and some context of the opposing assertion
- Credible support for the opposition's view
- An acknowledgement of, or concession to the opposing claim
- A transition and clear turn in the argument towards the student's position
- Refutes the opposition's claims showing they are incorrect, inconsequential, illogical, under-developed, etc.
- Has a clear conclusion that makes a firm statement in favor of the student's position
- Persuasive writing that is free from grammatical, spelling, and formatting errors with proper attribution given for sources.

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
