Student's refutation section should include:

A well-written topic sentence that:

Addresses both the opposition's argument and the "turn back"

Ties back to overall argument in thesis

Free from "be" verbs

Subject and some context of the opposing assertion

Credible support for the opposition's view

An acknowledgement of, or concession to the opposing claim

A transition and clear turn in the argument towards the student's position

Refutes the opposition's claims showing they are incorrect, inconsequential, illogical, under-developed, etc.

Has a clear conclusion that makes a firm statement in favor of the student's position Persuasive writing that is free from grammatical, spelling, and formatting errors with proper attribution given for sources.

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
