From Bauer:

- 1. Explain the various ways that Anastasius used to deal with the different barbarian tribes pestering Byzantium.
- 2. Describe the factions of chariot fans in Constantinople and why they were so dangerous, including both their reputation and their role in the Nika Revolt.
- 3. Review the definition of monophystisim (you may have to look it up). Why was this belief considered a heresy to the Eastern Christian church? Why was the doctrine embraced by the church in Alexandria?
- 4. Justinian's view of his responsibility in both the church & state seems like it might not be that different from previous emperors, yet Bauer suggests it represents a seismic shift. What is the difference between how he approaches his reign compared with other Roman emperors?
- 5. Name some of the impacts of the Bubonic Plague on the Eastern Empire.
